On behalf of the Home 44444 the Holidays Committee, we would like to thank you for participation in the 2011 Home 44444 the Holidays Festivities. It is important to note that if you find yourself unable to attend the event please let us know as soon as possible. We have a waiting list of potential vendors wishing to participate.

Upon arrival – DUE TO ACT SCHOOL TESTING TAKING PLACE THE ONLY VENDORS THAT WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FRONT DOORS ARE THOSE NUMBERED 108 and up. Please pull around to the rear of the high school. This is noted on the map. **I also have to ask that we do our best to keep noise to a minimum in the hall because there will be ACT testing going on in the other end of the hallway.** You may stop at the check in table if you have any questions or need assistance. The back doors will open at 7am with the event starting at 10 am. Once you enter the gym, you will find red and green blocks on the tables with numbers to assist in locating your table.

We ask that all vendors check-in with Tanya by 8:30 am. She will be located in the commons area. When you check-in, please bring your Chinese Auction item **AND** your red or green block that is on your table. Last year we drew from those blocks for a free table at this year's show. If it is not returned, you will not be entered. There is no charge for these but donations are appreciated.
